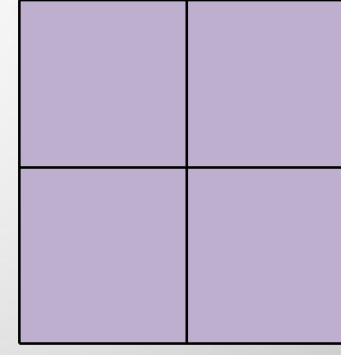
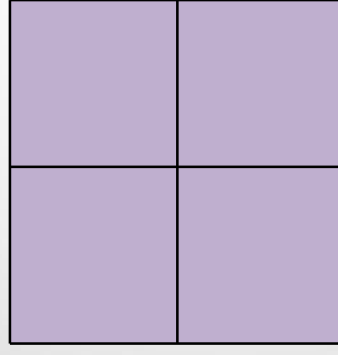
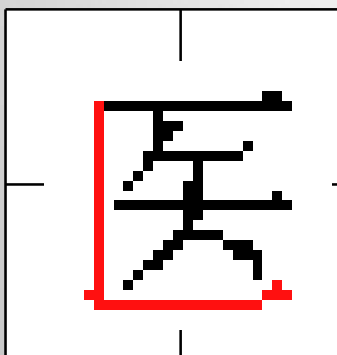
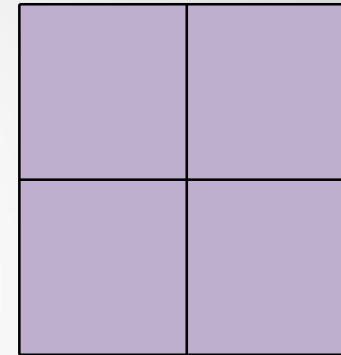
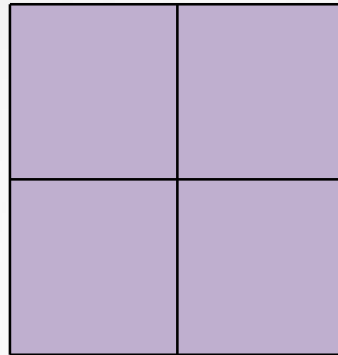
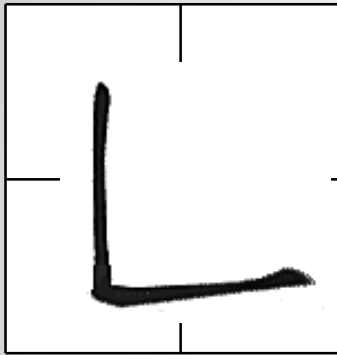
## shù zhé

- Written from top to bottom then turn to left

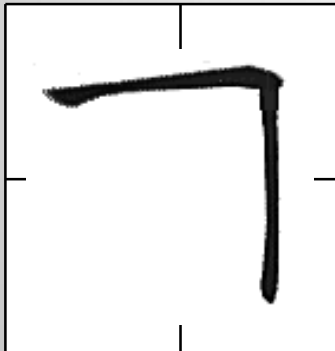
- As in the character  (doctor, medicine)

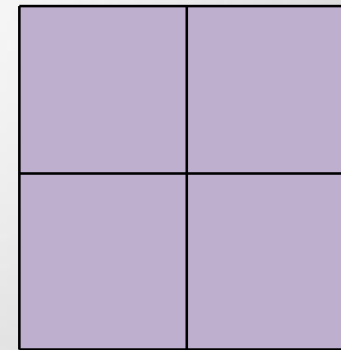
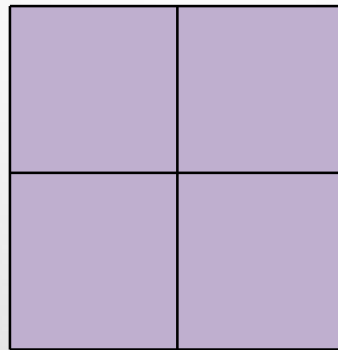
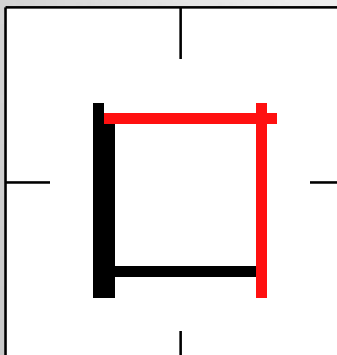
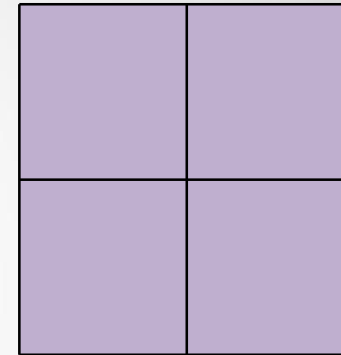
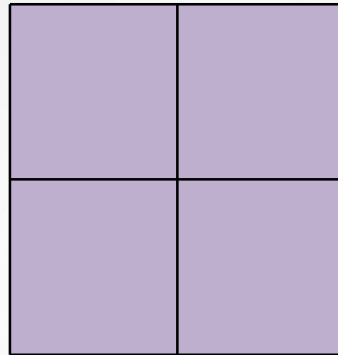
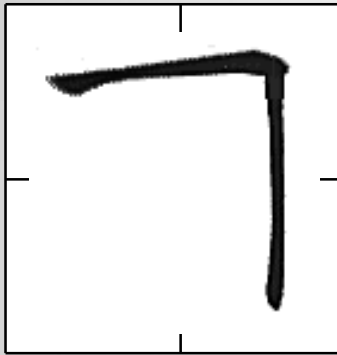


- Horizontal stroke with a vertical turn
